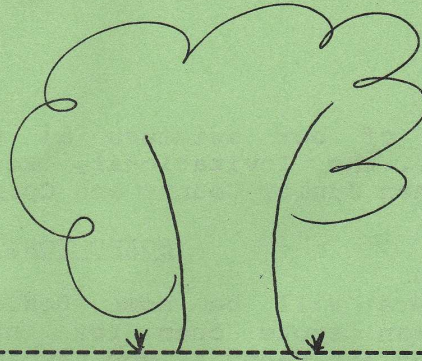

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

On July 17 the Pulte Home Corporation presented a review of their proposed development of the Newhall property to Woodlands residents. As a result of the Pulte presentation and a review of the draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR), the Board has written comments to be included in the Draft EIR which raise the following concerns:

1. Access to be provided through the Woodlands: The development as originally proposed would have access only from Ygnacio Valley Road. The EIR includes a section which comments on the impact on traffic in the Woodlands if access is also granted to the development through Rock Oak. The analysis finds that there would be minimal impact to the Woodlands from this access. I, and many others, feel this to be totally incorrect. Access to the proposed development from Rock Oak or any other Woodlands street would cause significant increases to our traffic. We should let our elected officials and other members of City government know of our opposition to any access to this development from the Woodlands.
2. The project will have a major negative impact on open space access on the northeast side of Walnut Creek.
3. Putting another traffic signal on the grade on Ygnacio Valley Road will cause increased traffic noise for Woodlands residents.
