Parcel on Oak Grove & Ygnacio

- Four Board members attended the Walnut Creek City Council meeting, Aug. 2, to hear Safeway's presentation for development of the parcel at the corner of the Shadelands Office Park
- Ed, President of Woodlands Board, spoke for the Association noting that he and Joe Casey previously met with Safeway at the recommendation of the city planners.
- Ed asked about a change in zoning and the effect it will have on the whole Shadelands Office Park; whatever use is developed here will have a substantial impact on the neighboring homes and businesses; it will increase retail competition for Citrus Center and Encina Grande; he asked for a high degree of public participation; and that a combination of uses be considered.
- Ed said that on Sept. 20, the City Council will consider a zoning-change request that Safeway plans to submit
- Justin said there should be a site-specific plan and it should include community input
- The Safeway parcel is about 25 acres
- Betty asked what specifically should we fight for?

- Ed said that before the city considers a zoning change, an EIR must be prepared which could take about 2 years
- Ed said that our Board should be represented as a stakeholder; he urged members to keep updated and stay involved in the process.
