Safeway Parcel on Oak Grove & Ygnacio:

- Safeway Parcel Mtg. Tues 6/12, 6:45 8:30 PM
- Reporting on the Advisory Committee (AC)Site Specific Plan, Ed said the Traffic evaluation presented at the 5/23 meeting reported that a baseline of traffic going through this intersection is 25,000 trips each day. The proposed development of Safeway's property could generate an additional 14,000 trips which is a 30% increase in daily trips.
- Possibility of adding another lane on Oak Grove Rd., but no cost figures were given for this
- Kay said the meetings at Safeway Participants seem to be concerned with the negative aspects: the scale and massiveness of the development
- The economic report says that current businesses in Citrus Center and Encina Grande are at 90% occupancy which is considered full, according to Ed
- Two more AC meetings at City Hall: June 27 and July 25.
