

#### REWARD

It is with a great deal of concern that we wish to report to you two recent incidents at the Woodlands Cabana Club. On August 22 and September 22 the club was vandalized. Indications are that the same person or persons may be responsible for both incidents. These are not just minor events as there was over \$8,000 worth of items stolen and property damaged. Some of the items stolen include a microwave oven, air compressor, stereo, amplifier, telephone answering machine, two mountain bicycles, membership rolodex file, bull horns, radio, ladders, and other assorted items. Additionally, damage to the building was extensive.

The Walnut Creek Police believe the vandal(s) are from the surrounding area, presumably someone who knew the club and its layout. It is unfortunate that incidents like these happen even in a quiet, close community like the Woodlands.

In view of the foregoing, the Woodlands Cabana Club board is offering a \$100 REWARD for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the robberies. Should you have any information that could be helpful,
