## Walnut Creek City Council Election - Kish Rajan Drops Out

On Tuesday, September 11, 2012, Walnut Creek City Councilman, Kish Rajan announced that he was suspending his campaign for re-election to City Council to take a position as Director of the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development. While his name will still appear on the election ballot he has indicated that he will not serve if elected and encourages

voters to vote for other qualified candidates.

That leaves four candidates remaining for the three openings for City Council – Mayor Bob Simmons, Barry Grove, Loella Haskew and Woodlands resident Justin Wedel. Woodlands residents should evaluate the candidates and vote on Election Day.

## Shadelands AC Meeting Addresses Neighborhood Concerns By Arsen Kitch

The 9th Shadelands Gateway Advisory Committee Meeting was held on August 29th at the Shadelands Art Center. Nearly 80 people, the largest turnout to date, showed up to provide feedback and listen to comments. The purpose of the meeting was to review and discuss neighborhood concerns about the potential development. The Committee focused on the following topics: economic viability, traffic concerns, benefit to neighborhood, a potential gas station, pedestrian/bike safety, and open space.

Several committee members questioned the overall idea of changing zoning due to the overwhelming opposition to the development from the Woodlands and Northgate neighborhoods. A debate took place about the merits of a development, with some members suggesting that the development would bring jobs and improve the viability of the struggling Shadelands office park. Mayor Pro Tem Kish Rajan and Committee Member Eric Harrison also suggested that a development would be a great gathering place for the neighborhood.

As in previous meetings, the comments received from the community were overwhelmingly against re-zoning. Existing questions about economic viability, impact on neighboring shopping centers, and traffic concerns were raised by the nearly 20 community members that spoke. The next Advisory Committee meeting is scheduled for 6:30pm on Monday, October 1st, at St. Mathews Church in the "Teen Center". The address is 399 Wiget Lane (off Ygnacio Valley Rd.) and the meeting is expected to last 2-3 hours.



On August 18th, as part of my Eagle Scout Service Project, 17 volunteers and scouts from Troop 227 collected donations of new and used shoes from the Woodlands Neighborhood. Flyers were distributed to every doorstep in the Woodlands and to both central mailboxes in the Citrus Walk neighborhood on August 7th. At the end of the day, forty-one 30 gal trash bags were collected, totaling 800 pairs of shoes! WAY TO GO WOODLANDS! The shoes were taken that day to the 1-800-GOT-JUNK franchise in South San Jose that provided transport to the Nashville-based global charity Soles4Souls (www.soles-4souls.org). 




